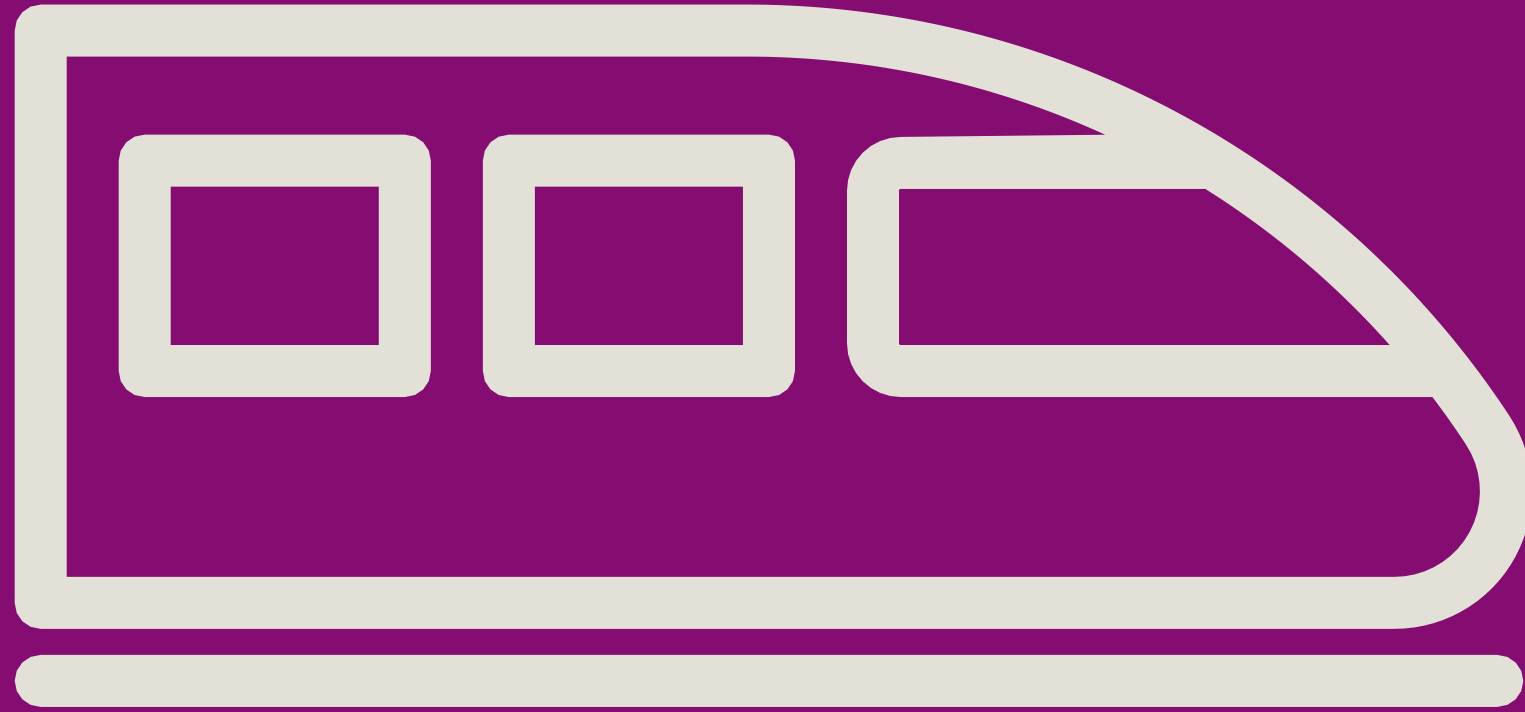

The number of clients increased last year by 85 million clients, 19.4% more than the previous year.

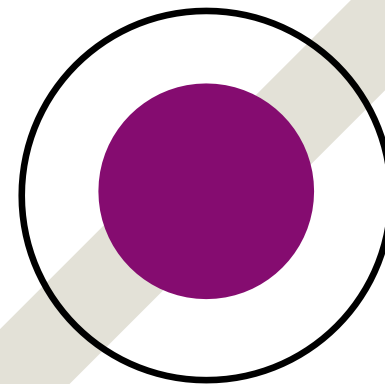

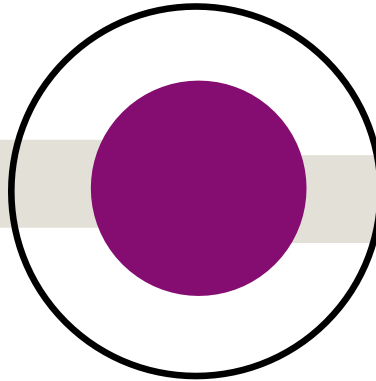


PSO

In December 2021, Renfe acquired 50% stake in Czech operator Leo Express' capital. Leo Express holds valid safety certificate in Czech Republic, Slovakia, Poland and Germany.
